VOTING RIGHTS REFER TO THE LEGAL RIGHTS OF ELIGIBLE CITIZENS TO PARTICIPATE IN ELECTIONS BY CASTING THEIR VOTES TO CHOOSE REPRESENTATIVES, MAKE DECISIONS ON PUBLIC ISSUES, AND DETERMINE THE OUTCOME OF ELECTIONS

A PERSON MUST BE A U.S. CITIZEN, BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD ON OR BEFORE ELECTION DAY, AND MEET ANY STATE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS.

AUGUST 18, 1920

TO MAKE SURE EVERYONE HAS A FAIR CHANCE TO VOTE

YES, PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE, JUST LIKE EVERYONE ELSE.

NO, ONLY CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES CAN VOTE IN FEDERAL ELECTIONS. VOTING IS ONE OF THE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BEING A CITIZEN.

VOTER REGISTRATION IS A PROCESS WHERE ELIGIBLE CITIZENS SIGN UP TO VOTE IN ELECTIONS. WHEN YOU REGISTER TO VOTE, YOU PROVIDE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, AND OTHER INFORMATION TO ELECTION OFFICIALS,

THE RULES ABOUT VOTING RIGHTS FOR CONVICTED FELONS VARY BY STATE- YOU HAVE TO CHECK WITH THE LAWS OF EACH STATE

IT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENFORCING AND CARRYING OUT THE LAWS MADE BY CONGRESS.

THE PRESIDENT

THE PRESIDENT IS CHOSEN THROUGH A SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION.

THE MAIN JOB OF THE PRESIDENT IS TO ENFORCE LAWS AND MAKE SURE THE COUNTRY RUNS SMOOTHLY.

NO, THE PRESIDENT CANNOT MAKE LAWS BY THEMSELVES. LAWS ARE MADE BY THE CONGRESS.

THE CABINET IS A GROUP OF PEOPLE CHOSEN BY THE PRESIDENT TO HELP ADVISE AND ASSIST THEM IN MAKING IMPORTANT DECISIONS.

THE MAIN ROLE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT IS TO SUPPORT THE PRESIDENT AND CARRY OUT TASKS ASSIGNED BY THEM.

THE PRESIDENT CAN SERVE 2 FOUR YEAR TERMS.

IT IS A PLEDGE TO UPHOLD AND DEFEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES AND TO FAITHFULLY EXECUTE THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE.
